HOW TO USE THE MAP

Lunar mapping is as old as humankind. Ancient civilizations learned to keep time according to lunar rhythms, and farmers still plant by the moon. Mapping out the way the moon travels through your natal chart each year will keep you attuned to the rhythms already pulling on your mind and body. Many call this phenomenon the lunar tides. Think of how the moon influences ocean and lake tides; it makes sense that we are also affected, considering the majority of our body composition is water.

The prevailing societal structures are linear, but we aren't meant for that. We are meant to rise and fall, to expand and contract. Your life, your work, your relationships - all are cyclical. Moon mapping can bring you into alignment with the times of the month for making, and the times for rest and rejuvenation. When to be social, when to plug in to your primary source.

You could get in pretty deep with this topic, but you don't have to. Each year takes us through a new and full moon in each sign, so if we take time at each lunar event to ask how it's going in the area of our lives lit by the sign of the moon, we get to check in on all areas of life semiannually. This has the potential to create massive ease in the way we spend our days.

NEW MOON

For many, the new moon is the beginning of the lunar cycle. When the face of the moon that we see from earth is dark, introspection and visioning are valued. New moons open portals to new pathways that lead one month, six months, a year, ten years into the future. In the days leading up to the new moon, I set aside time to get quiet and dream into the area of my natal chart lit by the coming new moon. Example: if the new moon is in Gemini, and I am Libra Rising, I know the new moon is activating my ninth house of travel and longterm study. I'll take a look at that house in terms of what's happening there, or what's been brewing, what needs cleaning out, and most importantly, what I would like to be living into by next decade. I dream my future. Farmers plant seeds by the new moon. After the new moon, it's time to begin working and reaching and tending to the intentions. New moon manifestation has a rich history and is taught many ways by many people. Try it out. Your way will present itself. Your body already knows how to do this. Allow your mind and heart to remember. This work offers us the chance to really think about how we are building our lives.

FULL MOON

The full moon is the middle of the lunar cycle. When the face of the moon that we see is fully lit celebration and harvest are valued. Think of the full illumination as a chance to take stock and see what needs to be revised during the second half of the lunar cycle. How are those intentions going? What's working? Do you need to course correct? Full moons are the time of harvesting crop. I like to light a big fire and burn off lists of what isn't working in my life - wishes, connections, commitments, mental clutter, anything keeping me from pursuing the new moon visions and dreams of the future. After the full moon, it's time to begin to reach inward, to listen for what will come next.

MOON VIBES

The moon changes signs every two and a half days, and it interacts with the sign it is inhabiting, creating a distinct vibe. Since it moves through all the signs each month, we get a little time with every vibe.

Moon in Aries is impulsive and initiating. Things begin. Aries is cardinal fire, and rules the first house.

Moon in Taurus loves the sensory world. Stubborn. Appreciates beauty. Taurus is fixed earth, and rules the second house.

Moon in Gemini is social and playful. Communication highlighted. Gemini is mutable air, and rules the third house.

Moon in Cancer is emotional. Home in focus. Cancer is cardinal water, and rules the fourth house.

Moon in Leo is expressive and creative. Self is highlighted. Leo is fixed fire, and rules the fifth house.

Moon in Virgo is hardworking. Detail oriented. Virgo is mutable earth, and rules the sixth house.

Moon in Libra asks for balance and compromise. Social life in focus. Libra is cardinal air, and rules the seventh house.

Moon in Scorpio is mysterious and complex. Secrets abound. Scorpio is fixed water, and rules the eighth house.

Moon in Sagittarius seeks forward motion. Imaginative and confident. Sagittarius is mutable fire, and rules the ninth house.

Moon in Capricorn is grounded in work and truth. Foundations. Capricorn is cardinal earth, and rules the tenth house.

Moon in Aquarius is rebellious. Individual growth and focus. Aquarius is fixed air, and rules the eleventh house.

Moon in Pisces is intuitive and mystical. Dream the day away. Pisces is mutable water, and rules the twelfth house.
